The Planning/Zoning Board of Appeals duties are as follows:

- · Hear and make a recommendations to the Board of Trustees on all petitions for variations, special use permits, amendments to the Zoning Ordinance
- · Review zoning petitions of importance in terms of planning and land decisions and policies stated by the Board of Trustees and/or the Comprehensive Plan for the Village

The Planning Committee meets on an **as needed** basis on the second Tuesday of each month at the Village Hall at 7:00 pm. Commissioners receive \$30 per meeting and must be a resident of the Village of Third Lake.

REMINDERS

- ★ Inoperable Vehicles It is a violation of the Village Ordinance to park or store a vehicle which is inoperable or unlicensed in residential driveways.
- ★ Clear Paths As a courtesy to Village residents and guests, property owners are required to trim trees and shrubs that extend into the sidewalks and streets. People should be able to walk on the sidewalks without bumping into them.
- ★ Building Permits If you are unsure whether or not your project requires a building permit, please call the Village Hall for confirmation.
 - Some projects that you may not know need permits include:
- Hot water heater replacement
- Air conditioning unit replacement
- Furnace replacement
- Interior remodeling
- ★ Overnight Parking There is no parking on Village streets between the hours of 2:00 am and 7:00 am. If you need to leave a car on the street overnight, you must call or email the Village Hall by 2:00 am. Leave a message including your name, address & the vehicle (s) license plate number (s). *** PLEASE DO NOT FORGET TO LEAVE THE LICENSE PLATE NUMBER (S)***
- ★ Pets and Pet Waste Pets are not permitted to roam the Village freely. All pets are required to be leashed when not on the owner's property. Allowing your dog to deposit waste on another resident's property or on Village sidewalks or streets and not picking up the waste is a violation of our Village Ordinance.
- ★ Trash & Yard Waste Waste Management Guidelines:

All waste materials must be placed out at the curb for collection by 6:00am the day of your collection, but not before 5:00pm the day before your pick-up. **This includes yard waste bags and containers.** All containers and any solid waste materials that are not collected must be removed from the curb by 8:00am the day after your scheduled collection. There is a 4 bag limit on yard waste bags per week.

Driving in the Village

The weather is getting warmer and the days are getting longer. Residents are spending more time outside walking, playing with their children, etc. Motorist please obey the speed limits and stop signs. Also, be on guard for children darting out between vehicles.

WATERCRAFT STICKERS/REGISTRATION

Get your boat stickers and keys starting April 1st. Every watercraft must have **both** a state registration sticker and a Village sticker. In order to purchase a Village sticker, **you must have a valid current state registration on file with the Village.** If you purchase a new boat, a processed application for state registration from the DNR will be accepted for this year. The Village has past years' registrations on file. If you are unsure of your status, please call the Village Hall. Boat stickers will not be issued without one of these documents. Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall or through the mail. To order by mail, send a check payable to the Village of Third Lake for the appropriate

amount, a copy of current state registration, and a list of your watercraft by type and state registration numbers. For your convenience, there is an application form on our website, www.thirdlakevillage.com. Or, visit the Village Hall during office hours. For Mariner's Cove boat launch keys contact the Mariner's Cove Home Owner's Association.

It's the Law!

All Persons born after January 1, 1998 are required by Illinois State Law to take and pass a boating safety course validated by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources and hold a valid boating safety certificate before they can operate a motorboat with an engine over 10 Horsepower. THIS INCLUDES PERSONAL WATER CRAFT!

≈ Persons at least 12 years of age and less than 18 years of age may operate a motorboat with over 10 horse-power only if they are accompanied on the motorboat and under the direct control of a parent or guardian or a person at least 18 years of age designated by a parent or guardian, or the motorboat operator is in possession of a Boating Safety Certificate issued by the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Law enforcement, authorizing the holder to operate motorboats.
