

National Cybersecurity Awareness Month

#BeCyberSmart

The College of Lake County is offering free seminars regarding cybersecurity on Tuesdays during the month of October. The discussions will take place on October 8, 15, 22 and 29 from 12 to 1pm and again from 6 to 7pm in Room A011. See the CLC Facebook page for further details on the topics being presented.

It's National Cyber Security Awareness Month, a time to brush up on smarter security practices for everyday actions like online shopping, surfing, and banking. Hackers are getting smarter in 2019, so if you own a computer, smartphone, or connected device, you need to take precautions. Here are a few tips:

- * Shake up your password. Consider using the longest password or passphrase permissible. Get creative and customize your standard password for different sites.
- * If you connect, you must protect. Whether it's your computer, smartphone, game device, or other network devices, the best defense against viruses and malware is to update to the latest security software, web browser, and operating systems.
- * Play hard to get with strangers. Cybercriminals use phishing tactics, hoping to fool their victims. If you're unsure who an email is from—even if the details appear accurate— or if the email looks "phishy," do not respond and do not click on any links or attachments found in that email.
- * Never click and tell. Limit what information you post on social media—from personal addresses to where you like to grab coffee. Keep personal information private. Do not post information about yourself, such as your full name, address, birthday, and even vacation plans.



LIKE TO HIKE?

Enjoy fall breezes and autumn colors while exploring designated Hike Lake County trails. At each preserve, look for the Hike Lake County logo at the trailhead to get you started on the right route. Complete just seven of the hikes between August 15 and November 30, and you'll earn a commemorative shield for your walking stick or a zipper pull (while supplies last).
