Fall is the perfect time to plant native trees and shrubs and the Lake County Forrest Preserve has a native tree and shrub sale happening on **Sunday, October 3rd** from 8 AM—12 PM. The **Illinois Food Scrap Coalition (IFSC)** is a not-for-profit organization and the Illinois Chapter of the United States Composting Council made up of over 100 Illinois municipalities, solid waste agencies, waste haulers, businesses, educators, and residents with a mission of advancing diversion and composting of organics in Illinois through advocacy, program implementation, market and business development, policy, and outreach.

Help us help get residents in Third Lake composting so we can reach our diversion, zero-waste and carbon-neutrality goals! The IFSC would like to help educate you about yard waste disposal and what should and should NOT go into the yard waste totes and kraft paper bags (landscape collection paper bags). LAKE NEWS

DRUCE LAKE BOAT LAUNCH

If you think that you will have difficulties removing your boat from the Druce Lake boat launch at the end of the season due to lower water levels, please contact the Village during business hours for special instructions.

DAM OPENING - NOVEMBER 1

The dam will be opening on November 1st. When the dam is open the water level will drop. Please have your boats out of the water.

PIERS -

Village Ordinance 21-01-01 requires you to remove your pier before the lake freezes to avoid damage.

FALL LEAF BURNING AND DISPOSAL

There are several ways to dispose of leaves this time of year. Composting, bagging or burning.

Burning -

Dry leaves, brush, branches under 1 1/2” in diameter, and yard waste may be burned between November 1st and November 30th during the hours of 9AM and 3PM only.

- Burning is only allowed in a fireproof barrel or other receptacle that is elevated above ground by at least 6” but no more than 24”.
- Burning is not permitted when wind is in excess of 15 mph, within 20’ of any building or structure, within 25’ of any wetland, lake or other body of water, or Lake County Forest Preserve property or on Village streets, sidewalks or other public right of way.
- Fire must be attended at all times by a person 16 years of age or older.
- Must have a water source and adequate means of delivering water immediately adjacent to the fire.

Bagging -

Leaf Stickers can be purchased at the Village Hall for \$1 during open business hours.
