BLUE GREEN ALGAE

Blue green algae (Harmful Algae Blooms, HAB) can appear on our Lakes from time to time. If you notice the algae, please call our office and report it. Lake County Health Department will come out and take a sample and send it to the lab. Results can take up to a week or two before we hear back and by that time the algae may have dissipated. Please review the guidance below from the Lake County Health Department to make the best decision for you and your family. If you see a YELLOW flag hoisted at the dam, the Village boat launch, Mariner's Cove boat launch or Druce Lake beach, check the Village website for important information. The Village will continue to monitor this all summer long with your help. Blooms can change over time so the Lake County Health Department warns, "If in doubt, STAY OUT!"





EXPLANATION OF AQUATIC PLANTS TOUR August 4th

The Village works with both the Lake County Health Department and Clarke Environmental services to determine the best treatment for a healthy balance of vegetation in the lakes. The date has been set for the Lake County Health Departments, "Explanation of Aquatic Plants." for Thursday August 4th, 2022. School Safety Alert

Stop for School Buses......It's The Law!

- · Vehicles must stop when the bus displays flashing lights and extends the stop signal arm. Vehicles may not pass until the flashing red lights and signal are turned off.
- · Never pass on the right side of a bus, where children enter or exit.
- · Vehicles traveling in the same direction are always required to stop
- Vehicles traveling from the opposite direction are required to stop, except on a divided highway.

Please remind new drivers in your family of the school bus law and to beware of students riding bikes or walking to school, especially in school zones. Students K-5 are difficult to spot when school buses and cars are present.

With the area schools back in session children are walking to their school bus stops in the mornings and walking home after being dropped off in the afternoons. Please be alert and look out for them as you drive through the neighborhoods. After school they are outside playing everywhere. Please watch for them as you are driving through the neighborhoods. PLEASE SLOW DOWN!

Pets and Pet Waste

Pets are not permitted to roam the Village freely and required to be leashed when not on the owner's property. Allowing your dog to deposit waste on another resident's property or on Village sidewalks or streets and not picking up the waste is a violation of our Village Ordinance. Please return your pets waste to your own garbage and not dispose of it on vacant property.

BE A SKEETER BEATER

Help keep the mosquito population down by eliminating standing water on your property. Dump water out of old tires, flip over unused buckets or planters and clean out clogged drain spouts where mosquitos like to lay eggs.

Boat stickers are required for every motorized watercraft on Third and Druce Lake. Both state registration and a Village sticker are required. In order to purchase a Village sticker, you must have a valid current state registration on file with the Village. Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall. An Ordinance violation of \$50 per watercraft will be issued for each boat in the lakes without a sticker. For more information about boating ordinances please go to ThirdLakeVillage.com

Boat stickers and keys are available for purchase on April 1st each year as listed below:

Non-Motorized Craft over 10 ft \$10.00

Craft with Electric Motors \$15.00

Gas Motorized Craft: 25 Horsepower or Less \$25.00

Over 25 Horsepower \$45.00

Village Boat Launch Key (one per household) \$10.00

Mariner's Cove launch - Contact Mariner's Cove

Non-resident, 3 consecutive day guest pass \$55.00 Non-resident, refundable key \$100

Boat Sticker Sales

Stickers can be purchased at the Village Hall during office hours or over the phone with a credit card and be mailed to your home. Sticker sales start April 1st each year or you may pay in advance starting in May. Illinois State registration must be current on file in order for us to issue you a sticker. Boat sticker forms for pre orders are located on our website at thirdlakevillage.com.


