

AERATORS ON THIRD LAKE

Aerators increase the oxygen levels in the water for healthy fish and improve water quality.

PETS ON THE LOOSE

All dogs and cats in Lake County Illinois must be leashed when not on their property. ORDINANCE 02-11-012 states that all dogs and cats, must be controlled by a leash when not on your property and not allowed to run at large in any part of the Village. Any dogs or cats found running at large may be apprehended and impounded. Any expense incurred in the handling of any such animal shall be borne by the owner, including impoundment fees.

JESSE WHITE EXTENDING DRIVER'S LICENSE AND ID CARD EXPIRATION DATES UNTIL JULY 31, 2022

Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White announced that expiration dates for driver's licenses, ID cards and learner's permits are being extended until July 31, 2022. The previous extension was set to end on March 31, 2022. As a result, expired driver's licenses, ID cards and learner's permits will remain valid until July 31, 2022.

This extension does not apply to commercial driver's licenses (CDL) and CDL learner's permits. As a reminder, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has extended the federal REAL ID deadline to May 3, 2023.

MOW RESPONSIBLY

Please do not blow grass clippings into the street. The grass blocks storm drains and cause flooding, standing water and damage to property. It also poses a road hazard for motorcycles. Grass clippings also cause water quality problems (like harmful algae) in our lakes.

LAKE NEWS



Boat stickers are required for every motorized watercraft on Third and Druce Lake. Both state registration and a Village sticker are required. In order to purchase a Village sticker, you must have a valid current state registration on file with the Village. Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall. An Ordinance violation of \$50 per watercraft will be issued for each boat in the lakes without a sticker. For more information about boating ordinances please go to ThirdLakeVillage.com

Boat stickers and keys are available for purchase on April 1st each year as listed below:

Non-Motorized Craft over 10 ft	\$10.00
Craft with Electric Motors	\$15.00
Gas Motorized Craft: 25 Horsepower or Less	\$25.00
Over 25 Horsepower	\$45.00
Village Boat Launch Key (one per household)	\$10.00
Mariner's Cove launch - Contact Mariner's Cove	
Non-resident, 3 consecutive day guest pass	\$55.00
Non-resident, refundable key	\$100

ORANGE FLAG

State law requires that boats towing person(s) on water skis or similar devices carry and use an orange or red skier-down flag, at least 12 x 12 inches in size, whenever the towed person(s) or associated equipment is down in the water.

LIFE VESTS

State law requires that personal floatation devices, life jackets or life vests MUST be available for each person aboard a watercraft.. It's also required to wear a PFD while operating a personal watercraft such as a see doo or jet ski.
