Committee Notes – March 6, 2023

#### LAKES

- Mayor Buckley stated that he and Trustee Hameister will be attending the ILMA conference this week and that Trustee Mateja and Ed Semrad, a Friends of the Lake member will be attending an ILMA workshop this week.
- Mayor Buckley stated that the dam is closed in order to prevent fish from escaping since the recent rains have caused the water on the back side of the dam to be even with the lake level.
- Mayor Buckley stated that the Dissolved Oxygen meter is on order and that a resident has volunteered to use his boat and take samples.
- Mayor Buckley stated that Clerk Smith is working on a handout for residents who purchase boat stickers that explains blue green algae. He said that he met with the Lake COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES MARCH 6, 2023

County Health Department regarding blue green algae. He also explained that he has been reading the minutes from Board meetings and that the blue green algae problem has been an issue in the village for the last 60 years.

## FINANCE AND POLICY

- Mayor Buckley explained that the budget contains the adjustments that were made at the last committee meeting. He said that the budget includes the Lake Ave. project. He said that he is currently working with the engineer for pricing and plans for potentially creating a cul-de-sac at the end of N. Lake Ave.
