ANNUAL SPRING TRASH CLEAN UP WEEK WEEK OF MAY 15TH



Annual Spring trash clean up day for all larger objects & debris is the week of May 15th. Pickup will be on your scheduled trash day. (Sunshine - Tuesday,

Mariner's Cove - Friday) The cleanup includes all residential household garbage, electronics, Christmas trees, sports & work out equipment, small appliances without freon, toilets, small motor vehicle parts drained of all fluids, furniture manageable for the driver to pick-up, carpeting no more than 50 lbs each, rolled & taped in 4' sections and no more than 10 rolls. Not accepted is yard waste, appliances with freon, tires, batteries, concrete, oil/gas, propane tanks, tree stumps, chemicals and construction material.
