Zoning Ordinance changes – discussion points from different commissioners

- Remove any actual prohibited or permitted uses within the definitions that is allowed by another ordinance, it weakens the whole document
- If we have a separate ordinance forbidding something, don't include it in this Planning & Zoning ordinance because it can be challenged
- Be sure to address ADU Accessory Dwelling Units
- Home Occupation needs a definition
- Add acreage requirement to Church similar to that used with schools
- Clarify where the micro-brewery and micro-winery production limits came from and if we need to increase them

- Outdoor storage of materials hasn't been defined yet. It is thought to be defined within the IBC,
 Bob Lizzo will look this up for discussion at the next meeting
- Special Use Procedures and Standards document dated 1/4/24
 - 1. In section C8b remove the words the conduct of
 - 2. In section C8d add the wording including hours of operation
 - 3. In section D1c add the wording pedestrian access
 - 4. In section 2i about drive-through facilities, add *allow the Village the right to regulate hours of operation*
