# Time to Enjoy Our Lakes!

Please do the following:



#### **PIERS**

If you have a pier, you must display your address visibly on your pier.

#### **NO WAKE AREA**

A "No Wake" area is declared for the area beginning at the shoreline and extending 150" into the lake in all areas of Third Lake under jurisdiction of the Village. The term "wake" is defined as a movement of the water created by a watercraft underway great enough to disturb a boat at rest. In addition, if a watercraft operating outside the "no wake" area has in tow a person on water skis, tube or similar contrivance, such person or device shall not enter the "no wake" area.

#### ADDITIONAL "NO WAKE" ZONE

A lake-wide "no wake zone" will be enforced on Third Lake when the water level is over the spillway fish gate or as determined by a Village Official. This will be indicated by a red flag at the Village Dam and the Village boat launch.

#### TRAFFIC RULES

When two watercraft are approaching each other "head on" or nearly so (so as to involve risk of collision), each watercraft must bear to the right and pass the other watercraft on its left side. When a watercraft is approaching a watercraft propelled solely by sails or oars, the motorboat must yield the right of way to the sailboat or rowboat.

Drive your watercraft counter-clockwise around Third Lake for safety reasons.

#### AGE OF OPERATOR

No person under 10 years of age may operate a motorboat. This includes personal watercraft. Persons at least 10 years of age and less than 12 years of age may operate a motorboat only if:

- accompanied on the motorboat or personal watercraft and under the direct control of a parent or guardian, or person at least 18 years of age designated by a parent or guardian. Persons at least 12 years of age and less than 18 years of age may operate a motorboat or personal watercraft only if:
- they are accompanied on the motorboat/personal watercraft and under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian -or- a person at least 18 years of age designated by their parent or guardian.

#### **CATCH AND RELEASE**

Please practice catch and release from **April 1st to June 15** for large and small mouth bass, walleye and northern pike. The Village promotes the practice of catch and release for all fishermen at all times.



#### **BOAT LAUNCH**

Hours: 7:00am - 9:00pm

- ⇒ Please close gates immediately upon entering and leaving all boat launches.
- ⇒ Trailers may not be parked on streets or Village boat launch areas.

Violators will be towed at their owner's expense.



#### **BE PREPARED**

Springtime can be unpredictable and extreme weather events can happen anytime. Being prepared is key and knowing the terms used to describe tornado threats:

Tornado Watch: This means tornadoes are possible near your area.

Tornado Warning: This means a tornado has been sighted by someone or indicated by weather radar. Go to your designated safe place in your home. Tornado Emergency: TAKE COVER! This means there is a severe threat to human life and catastrophic damage is expected.

#### How to be Prepared For All Kinds of Weather:

Determine the safest location in your home. Basements or alternate areas like closets, small interior hallways and bathrooms without windows are the best. Cover yourself with a mattress or cushions.

Have a plan and conduct periodic tornado safety drills with your family members.

# Spring Leaf Burning Ends May 15th

Dry leaves, brush, branches under 1 1/2" in diameter and yard waste may be burned through May15th.

- Burning is permitted 9 am 3 pm
  - Allowed only in a fireproof barrel or receptacle and must be elevated above ground by at least 6" but no more than 24".

#### **Burning is not permitted:**

- When wind is in excess of 15 mph
- Within 20' of any building or structure
- Within 25' of any wetland, lake or other body of water, or Lake County Forest Preserve
- On Village streets, sidewalks or other public right of way.
- Fire must be attended at all times by a person 16 years of age or older.

Must have a water source and adequate means of delivering water to the fire.
