

- Passed Village Calendar for Year 2025.

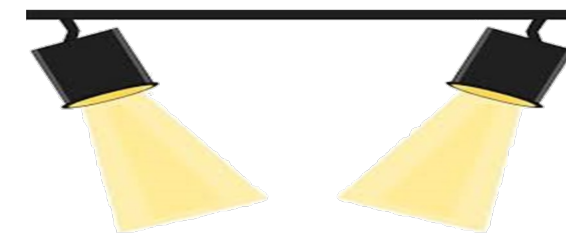

Burning Yard Waste?

Remember to follow Ordinance 09-07-02 on the Village website when burning yard waste to ensure the safety of your family and neighbors. Yard waste may be burned between November 1st and 30th, between 9AM and 3PM.

Please remember the following:

- Wind and gusts must not exceed 15mph when burning
- No burning within 20 feet of any building or structure
- No burning within 25 feet of any wetland, lake, or forest
- Don't burn without a water source adjacent to the fire
- No burning on Village streets, sidewalks, or public right-of-way
- The fire must be supervised by a person 16 years or older
