

SNOW REMINDERS



As much as we love the beauty of fresh fallen snow, the roads need to be plowed. The plow operators do their best to provide clean streets, but occasionally may hit a mailbox or scrape a section of sod near the curb. If this happens, please report the incident to the Village Hall.

In general, a plow truck will make the first pass to open the roads and will come back at a later time to fine tune the rest, so please be patient.

Please remember to **shovel your sidewalks** and around **fire hydrants** to keep us all safe. Help the postal service by clearing in front of your **mailbox**.

There is **no parking** of any vehicle on the streets at any time **within 12 hours after a snowfall of one inch or more**. Violating this ordinance will result in the issuance of a parking fine and/or towed vehicle.
