As much as we love the beauty of fresh fallen snow, the roads need to be plowed. The plow operators do their best to provide clean streets, but occasionally may hit a mailbox or scrape a section of sod near the curb. If this happens, please report the incident to the Village Hall.

In general, a plow truck will make the first pass to open the roads and will come back at a later time to fine tune the rest, so please be patient.

Please remember to **shovel your sidewalks** and around **fire hydrants** to keep us all safe. Help the postal service by clearing in front of your **mailbox**.

There is **no parking** of any vehicle on the streets at any time **within 12 hours after a snowfall of one inch or more.** Violating this ordinance will result in the issuance of a parking fine and/or towed vehicle.
