FIRST

SPRING LEAF BURNING

APRIL 15th - MAY 15th

Dry leaves, brush, branches under 1 1/2" in diameter, and yard waste may be burned between April 15 & May 15 and between November 1st & November 30th only. Burning is permitted between the hours of 9 am & 3 pm. Fires must be attended at all times by someone 16 years and older, and there must be a water source and adequate means of delivering water immediately adjacent to the fire.

Burning is not permitted:

- When wind is in excess of 15 mph.
- Within 20' of any building or structure.
- Within 25' of any wetland, lake or other body of water, or Lake County Forest Preserve property.
- On Village streets, sidewalks or other public right of way.

APRIL IS SEVERE WEATHER, PREPARDNESS MONTH

Illinois averages 53 tornadoes per year. Spring is a good time to plan ahead and be prepared for tornadoes and severe weather.

- Keep all important records and documents in a secure waterproof container
- Make an inventory of possessions using lists and photos/videos
- Insure your property and possessions
- Know how to shut off electricity, gas, and water
- Compile an emergency kit and "go bag" to help your family for at least three days during extended power outages or evacuations
- Make sure flashlights with fresh batteries are ready
- Generators should only be run outside, never indoors or in enclosed spaces.

- Passed Resolution No. R25-03-02 a resolution authorizing an agreement with Wisconsin Lake & Pond.


