## **ComEd Offers Energy Support Resources for Rising Electricity Bills**

We want to make you aware of a change that will likely impact electricity bills beginning this summer. Last year, PJM, the federally-regulated body that is responsible for the organized energy markets and transmission grid operations in our region, held its annual capacity auction to secure future electricity supply based upon projected demand. For reasons including power plant retirements, increased load, changes to regional market rules, and more frequent instances of extreme weather, the auction-based capacity prices applicable in Illinois starting June 1, 2025, have risen significantly. The resulting costs appears monthly on each customer's electricity bill as part of the supply charge.



This capacity charge is not set by ComEd and the money it collects goes to owners of power plants, not ComEd. If you are a ComEd supply customer, the cost of that capacity makes up part of the Supply portion of your monthly bill, but ComEd passes it through with no mark up and no profit. Other energy suppliers may deal with that charge in different ways. **ComEd** does not benefit from this cost increase in any way.

We estimate that the average electric bill will increase by \$10.60. However, each customer's bill is unique and will vary based on factors including your energy usage and your energy supplier. ComEd cannot estimate how this charge may affect the bills of customers served by other suppliers.

We know this is an additional expense for many. We have been working since the auction results were announced to understand the impact they will have on our commercial and residential customers.

Through a suite of bill-assistance and energy-management programs, ComEd continues to support customers, particularly those vulnerable to economic hardships, including:

### Bill Assistance:

- **Payment Arrangements** of up to 12 months for eligible residential customers with past-due balances.
- Fresh Start Services offers online and person-to-person support to help educate customers on energy-management and financial-assistance options.
- Catch Up and Save helps customers eliminate past-due balance and provides stabilized monthly billing through new enrollment in the Supplemental Arrearage Reduction Program.

#### **Billing Options:**

- Budget Billing helps customers anticipate electric bills costs by providing them with a predictable monthly payment based on their electricity use from the last 12 months.
- **Due Date Extensions** of up to 21-days to help eligible customers avoid past-due balances.
- Deposit and Late-payment Charge Waivers for one year to income-eligible customers, along with the return of any current deposit.

### **Energy Management:**

- High-usage Alerts enable customers to receive alerts when their usage is trending higher than normal to help manage overall energy use.
- Peak Time Savings enables customers to reduce their energy use during peak usage times and earn credits on future
- **Hourly Pricing** offers customers the opportunity to purchase electricity at the hourly market price.
- The ComEd Energy Efficiency Program offers award-winning energy-management solutions to help customers reduce overall costs, which helps them avoid falling behind on their electric bills.
